
Papilio Shell

Description

Forming part of the iconic seating collection of the same name, the Papilio Shell chair comes either with a shell entirely in polypropylene or with a polypropylene shell padded and covered in fabric or leather. The base comes in several versions: with four steel or wooden legs, with a swivel four-spoke frame, or with a fixed four-spoke frame with wheels. The shape of the back of Papilio Shell calls to mind the multicoloured wings of a butterfly ready to take flight. It is this detail that inspired the name, “papilio” being the Latin term for butterfly.

polypropylene

Shell upholstery (SH1-SH2-SH3-SH4):

Bayfit® (Bayer®) flexible cold shaped polyurethane foam

Support frame (SH1-SH1):

painted or bright chromed tubular steel and steel profiles

Legs (SH2-SH2):

oak solid wood

Support frame (SH3-SH3-SH4-SH4):

painted or bright brushed die-cast aluminium

Wheels (SH3-SH3):

plastic material for soft surfaces or plastic material for hard surfaces

Double-side ferrules (SH1-SH1-SH2-SH2):

plastic material/felt

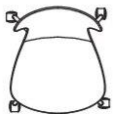
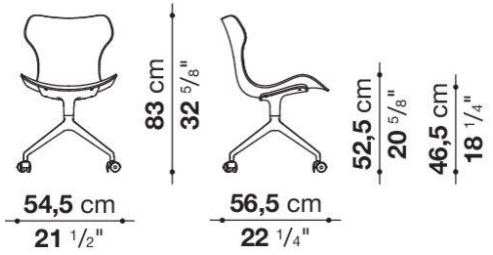
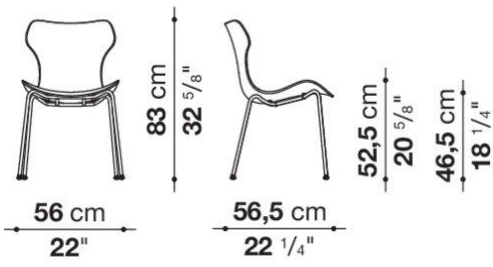
Double ferrules (SH4-SH4):

felt or plastic material

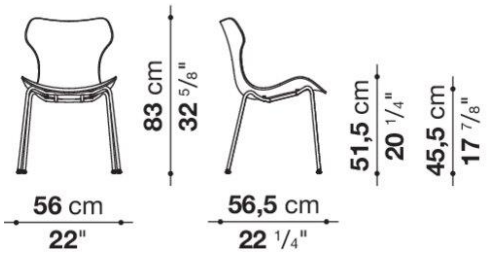
Cover:

fabric or Gamma leather

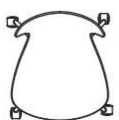
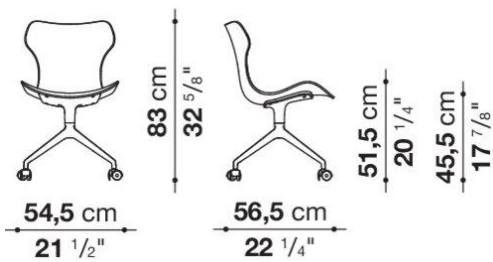
