Papilio Shell

Description

Forming part of the iconic seating collection of the same name, the Papilio Shell chair comes either with a shell entirely in polypropylene or with a polypropylene shell padded and covered in fabric or leather. The base comes in several versions: with four steel or wooden legs, with a swivel four-spoke frame, or with a fixed four-spoke frame with wheels. The shape of the back of Papilio Shell calls to mind the multicoloured wings of a butterfly ready to take flight. It is this detail that inspired the name, "papilio" being the Latin term for butterfly.

painted or bright chromed tubular steel and steel profiles

oak solid wood

Support frame (SH3-SH3I-SH4-SH4I):

painted or bright brushed die-cast aluminium

Wheels (SH3-SH3I):

plastic material for soft surfaces or plastic material for hard surfaces

Double-side ferrules (SH1-SH1I-SH2-SH2I):

plastic material/felt

Double ferrules (SH4-SH4I):






